How to borrow from your library

- You must have your library card with you whenever you wish to borrow
- Most library items may be borrowed for 4 weeks. DVDs and toys are loaned for 2 weeks. HSC lending books are loaned for 1 week

Returning library items

- Library items can be returned to any one of the three libraries
- Overdue fees are charged for late returns of library materials
- All library members are given a one week grace period on borrowed items before an overdue notice with the first fee is issued
- If this notice has not been paid for and overdue items not returned, a second notice with a second fee will be sent out 2 weeks after the first notice

Renewing library items

To avoid fees, return items on or before the due date or ask for a renewal over the phone or in person. Items can be renewed once if they are not overdue or reserved for another person.

Available for loan

There are no limits when borrowing:

- Fiction books and paperbacks
- Children's picture books
- Young adult books
- Graphic novels
- Talking books
- Literacy/Basic English resources
- Non-English language resources
- Videos

However, some limits do apply:

- 4 books per subject per family for each school project
- 5 DVDs per card
- 5 HSC lending books
- 5 non-English language books ordered from the State Library of New South Wales
- 5 non-English language videos / DVDs
- 10 magazines
- 10 pieces of sheet music
- 20 CDs (5 non-English language CDs)
- 20 CD-ROMs
- Toys and party packs (limit is dependent on type of membership)

Lost or damaged items

You are responsible for all items borrowed on your card. If any items are lost or damaged beyond repair, you will be required to pay the replacement cost and a processing fee. Please do not attempt to repair damaged library items at home.
