HOME LIBRARY SERVICE:

Holroyd City Council Library Service offers a warm, friendly and free Home Library Service to all residents of Holroyd, who are unable to personally visit the Library for reasons of age, illness or disability.



HOW TO JOIN:

Simply contact the Special Needs Librarian on 9840 9919, where an application form will be completed.

Personal details will need to be given. You will be asked what items you would like to borrow and how many. A delivery time will be organised for you.

An original doctor's certificate must be provided for this service.



WHAT CAN YOU BORROW?

The Home Library Service provides the following items for Home Library members to borrow for one month:

- Large print books
- Normal print books (fiction/non fiction)

- Talking books - cassettes and CDs
- Videos
- Magazines
- CDs
- DVDs
- CD-ROMs

The Special Needs Librarian, according to the preferences indicated by Home Library members, will select these items.

Bulk loans are also available to institutions such as nursing homes, retirement villages, aged care centres and senior citizens clubs.
